## 5.9L DIESEL ENGINE

NOTE:

The A/C compressor may be removed and repositioned without disconnecting the refrigerant lines or discharging the refrigerant system. Discharging is not necessary if servicing the compressor clutch, clutch coil or engine.

- 1. Disconnect and isolate the negative battery cable.
- 2. Recover the refrigerant from the refrigerant system (Refer to 24 Heating and Air Conditioning/Plumbing Standard Procedure).
- Remove the accessory drive belt (Refer to 07 -Cooling/Accessory Drive/BELT, Serpentine -Removal).
- 4. Remove the bolt (1) that secures the A/C suction and discharge line assembly (2) to the A/C compressor (3).
- 5. Disconnect the refrigerant line assembly from the A/C compressor and remove and discard the seals.
- 6. Install plugs in, or tape over all of the opened refrigerant line fittings and compressor ports.
- 7. Disconnect the wire harness from the clutch field coil wire lead connector (4).
- 8. Remove the four bolts (1) that secure the A/C compressor (2) to the mounting bracket (3) located on the right side of the cylinder block (4).
- Remove the A/C compressor from the engine compartment.
